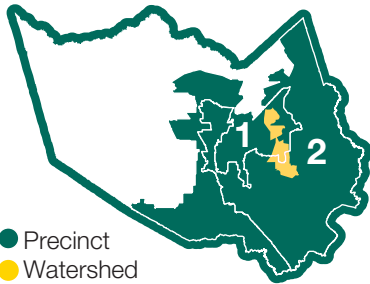

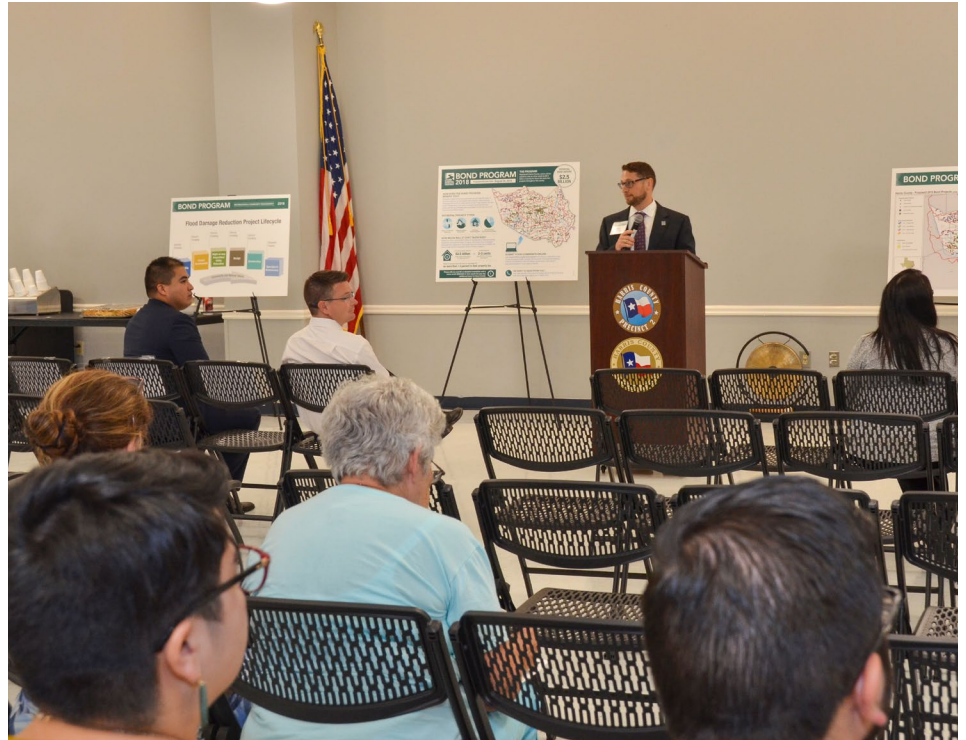

WATERSHED APPROACH

In Carpenters Bayou watershed, the Flood Control District will focus on subdivision drainage improvements in cooperation with the Harris County Engineering Department. No major capital projects are planned in Carpenters Bayou watershed. Voluntary home buyouts for structures that meet Flood Control District requirements are also planned for this watershed.

BENEFITS

Bond Program projects would benefit residents of the Carpenters Bayou watershed through subdivision drainage improvements that would increase the level of service for neighborhoods constructed before current drainage criteria was in place.

COMMUNITY INPUT REVIEW PROCESS

Each public comment was considered individually by the Flood Control District. Comments were reviewed to identify and categorize the ideas, concerns, requests, and information presented. This input was then categorized by theme for incorporation into the proposed Bond Program, and the Flood Control District team responded to each community input comment received. Themes identified for Carpenters Bayou watershed are detailed below.

COMMUNITY INPUT SUMMARY

From May 30 through August 3, 2018, the Flood Control District received a total of six community input comments related to flood damage reduction concerns in the Carpenters Bayou watershed. Common themes expressed through community input include channel modification, stormwater detention, and concerns that fall outside the Flood Control District's jurisdiction.

The community input in this watershed covered a range of topics. A request for channel modification sought to improve drainage on channel N111-00-00. A separate resident suggested using local facilities for stormwater detention, including Texaco Country Club, Brock Park, and Old East Belt Hospital. The same resident also recommended prioritizing work in the southern end of Harris County.

Community input that fell outside of the Flood Control District's jurisdiction included local drainage issues due to overland flow and ponding. A separate comment recommended gating Lake Conroe, which is also outside of the Flood Control District's jurisdiction. The concerns expressed within the Carpenters Bayou watershed that fall outside of the Flood Control District's jurisdiction require coordination with other municipalities and/or organizations to address these comments.
