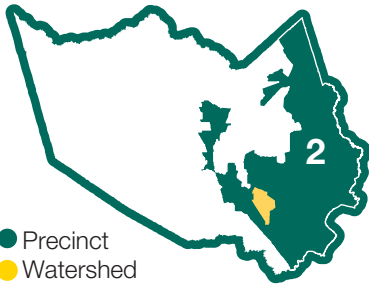

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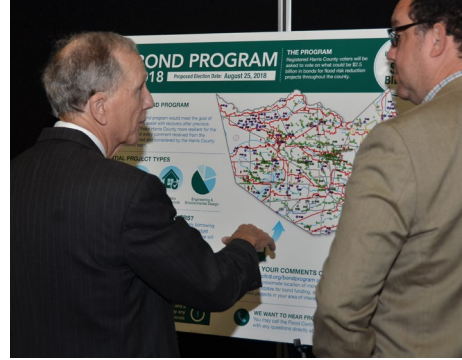


WATERSHED APPROACH

The Flood Control District will focus on completing a general investigation of drainage concerns in the Vince Bayou watershed. The general investigation will involve an analysis of Citizen Service Requests, a review of previous drainage studies, and a public meeting to gather input from citizens. The general investigation will lead to a preliminary engineering report, final design plans, and construction of identified drainage improvement projects. Voluntary home buyouts for structures that meet Flood Control District requirements are also planned for this watershed.

BENEFITS

The proposed investigation and resulting projects would help define drainage benefits in the Vince Bayou watershed. Some projects would address long-standing drainage problems in the watershed.

COMMUNITY INPUT REVIEW PROCESS

Each public comment was considered individually by the Flood Control District. Comments were reviewed to identify and categorize the ideas, concerns, requests, and information presented. This input was then categorized by theme for incorporation into the proposed bond program, and the Flood Control District team responded to each community input comment received. One Citizen Service Request was received. Themes identified for Vince Bayou watershed are detailed below.

COMMUNITY INPUT SUMMARY

From May 30 through August 3, 2018, the Flood Control District received one community input comment related to flood damage reduction concerns in the Vince Bayou watershed. Themes expressed in this comment include requests for additional flood damage reduction studies, storm repairs, and transparency.

The comment included the following requests:

- Include additional large-scale flood damage reduction studies for consideration in the Bond Program, instead of focusing on smaller improvements
- Repair damage to rip-rap along Glenmore Ditch (G108-00-00) near Hays Street and Albemarle Drive in the nearby San Jacinto River watershed
- Remove large vegetative debris and sediment buildup from Glenmore Ditch (G108-00-00) under Portsmouth Street Bridge in the nearby San Jacinto River watershed.
- Provide additional information regarding how projects and the associated cost estimates were determined for the inclusion in the Bond Program
