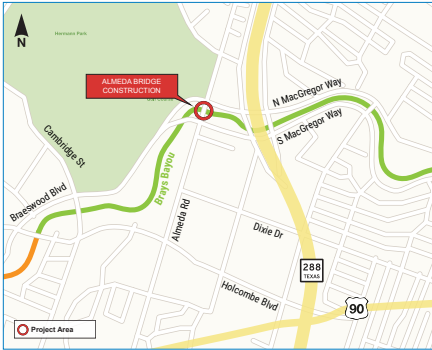

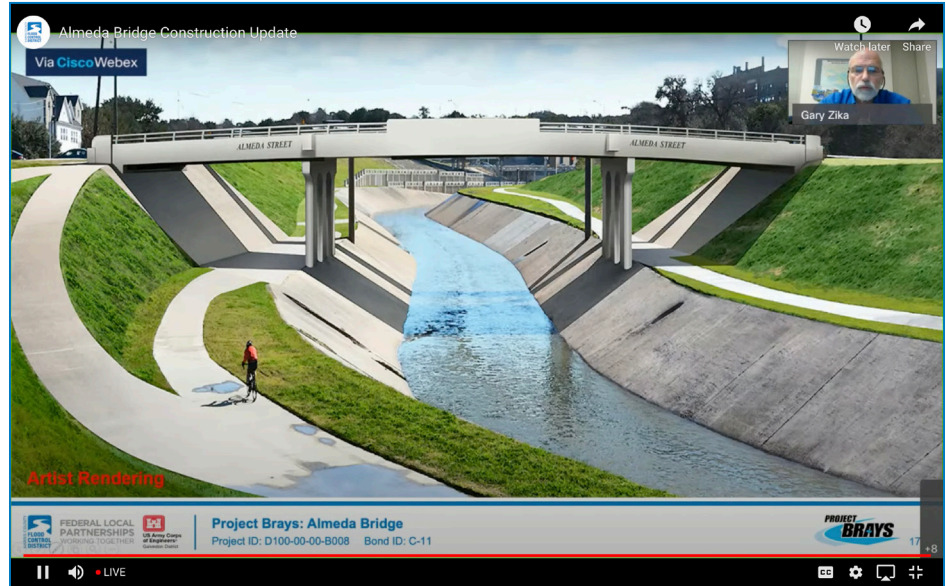

Harris County Flood Control District hosted a virtual presentation and provided the opportunity for community members to ask questions about the Almeda Rd Bridge project. The meeting was held virtually on the Public Input platform on Wednesday, January 27, 2020 from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

As a part of Project Brays, the Almeda Rd bridge will be reconstructed in an effort to reduce flooding along Brays Bayou. The current bridge will be demolished and replaced with a higher, longer and wider bridge.
