MEETING OVERVIEW

Harris County Flood Control District hosted a virtual presentation and provided the opportunity for community members to ask questions about the S. Rice and Chimney Rock Bridges and Meyergrove Stormwater Reconstruction project. The meeting was held virtually on the Public Input platform on Wednesday, October 12, 2020 from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

As a part of Project Brays, the S. Rice and Chimney bridges are to be reconstructed in an effort to reduce flooding along Brays Bayou. The project will demolish the current bridges and replace them with higher, longer, and wider bridges. The Meyergrove Stormwater Detention basin is part of the 2018 Bond Project to reduce the risk of flooding in the area.
